A 2017 State Council ruling affirmed Professor Hornig's right to a pension by virtue of long service.
3	Failure to Register/Remit NSSF Contributions	Social Security Law (Decree 13955/1963), Arts. 9, 10, 16, 73	✓ Verified	The 1963 Social Security Law obligates employers to register employees and pay contributions. Non-registration despite payroll deductions directly violates this law.
4	31-Year Contractual Misclassification	Labor Code Article 58	✓ Verified	Lebanese labor law forbids using endless renewals to deny permanent status. Article 58 specifies that a contract repeatedly renewed for over two years is deemed an open-ended (permanent) employment.
5	Ignoring Binding Court Orders	Cassation Court Decision 103/2023; Shura Council Decision 212/2017	⚠️ Partially Verified	Non-enforcement of final judgments contravenes fundamental legal principles. International jurisprudence confirms that failure to execute final court decisions

6	Life-Threatening Healthcare Denial	Labor Code Art. 61; ICESCR Art. 12; National Social Security Law	⚠️ Partially Verified	violates the right to a fair trial and an effective remedy. Lebanon's Social Security scheme should cover employees' healthcare. His exclusion from any health fund violated these standards, as evidenced by an emergency surgery he had to self-fund.
7	Bonded Labor via Work Permit Fees (1994–2009)	Decree 17561/1964; ILO Convention 95	✓ Verified	Under Lebanese law, employers must arrange and pay for foreign employees' work permits/residency. This practice meets the ILO definition of bonded labor.
8	Denial of End-of-Service Indemnity (EOSI)	Labor Code; Civil Service Law	⚠️ Partially Verified	If treated as a private contract employee, Hornig should get end-of-service indemnity as per the Labor Code. If treated as a civil servant, he'd get a pension. In reality he got neither.
9	Exclusion from Family, Housing, Education Benefits	Civil Service Law & Budget Laws; ICESCR Art. 10	⚠️ Partially Verified	Lebanese civil servants are entitled to family allowances and other benefits. Hornig's exclusion, solely due to nationality/status, contravenes both domestic policy and the ICESCR's mandate.
10	Falsification of Payroll Codes	Public Accounting and Budget Law; Audit Court principles	⚠️ Partially Verified	The claim is that Hornig's salary was mis-coded under temporary/hourly worker budget lines to avoid showing a permanent post.
